The **Hessische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung** (Hessian State Centre for Civic Education) was founded in 1954.

It is an integral part of political life and political culture in Hesse.

The **Hessische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung** is an institution of the Federal State of Hesse and directly assigned to the Prime Minister of Hesse. It is the only Hessian institution to carry out civic educational activities by public order.

A body of nine members of the Hessian parliament – the Board of Trustees – ensures that the activities are nonpartisan.

The **Hessische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung** „carries out civic, nonpartisan educational work in the Federal State of Hesse.

Its mission is in particular to further the development of liberal and democratic citizen awareness through civic educational work ...”

The **Hessische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung** offers manifold services to the citizens of our Federal State.

It offers a wide range of **publications** on central themes of civic education and on contemporary political developments.

It organises **special conferences and series of lectures** on both essential fields of politics and contemporary political issues.

It carries out **seminars** and supports pedagogic activities and **projects** of other Hessian educational centres.

It cooperates with all democratic groups within society and adapts its activities to their fields of interest.

It offers its innovational and conceptual **know-how** in the field of educational work to all interested persons.

It promotes **excursions** to the memorials for the victims of National Socialism and furthers the educational work of museums along the former borderline between East- and West-Germany.



The **HLZ** has a **lending library**, whose inventory includes approximately 8,000 books and over 1,000 audiovisual media.

Video and Internet workstations are available for personal research.

OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) **allows visitors to search the inventory** of the HLZ library and of regional, national and international libraries. Qualified staff can offer help and advice.

Professional journals and nationwide dailies are available for reading on site.

Exhibitions, lectures and other activities are regularly offered on the premises of the HLZ.

Authors have a chance to present their latest publications at the monthly series **„Literature and politics after work”**.
